

Coronavirus Patient Safety Procedures- Emergency, Urgent and Routine Care

1. When scheduling your appointment, please inform staff if you have experienced a fever, dry cough, gastrointestinal upset, headache or fatigue, recent loss of taste or smell, have tested positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed to someone with symptoms or have tested positive to COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
2. Bring your completed, updated forms: **patient information, medical history, financial, and COVID-19 patient screening form** (complete the column on the left, you will or be completing the right column on your appointment day).
3. Before your appointment, brush and floss your teeth at home, bring safety glasses, goggles, sunglasses if not wearing glasses, your own pen for signing papers
4. Your temperature will be taken. **Normal 98.6F (37C) or lower.** You will be rescheduled if you have a fever.
5. You will be escorted to your dental chair. We recommend washing your hands with soap and water before sitting in the dental chair.
6. Remove your face covering. You will be rinsing with a 1.5% hydrogen peroxide mouthwash for 1 minute for oral disinfection
7. Dental procedure using aerosol reduction techniques.
8. Put face mask on. Wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer at the front desk.
9. Check out at front desk. Call us if within 14 days you have COVID-19 symptoms or test positive for COVID-19.
